The President's Perspective

Members of the St. Joseph Community Alliance are partnering to evaluate the feasibility of developing a new multi-use athletic complex. This project would likely be a public/private partnership, both in funding and operation. Such a complex could be a significant addition to the sports facility inventory that already exists in our community.

A new multi-use complex would improve the quality of life in our community, improve health and economic outcomes for our region and create a sports destination that would drive economic development through tourism-generated dollars. The intent of the study is to determine the overall feasibility of a project, the type of facility and activities that should be the focus of a facility, and potential locations for a facility.

The study will be conducted by Sports Facilities Companies (SFC) with oversight from Clancy's Sports. SFC helps communities plan, fund, develop and operate sports, recreation and entertainment facilities. Clancy's Sports will provide more detailed insights on sports programming, financial projections and operational strategies.
