FARM CITY BREAKFAST BRINGS AG BUSINESS COMMUNITY TOGETHER

(St. Joseph, MO) -- The St. Joseph Chamber of Commerce will host its 15th annual Farm City Breakfast on Friday, March 22, 2019. The event is held in celebration of National Ag Day. It recognizes the farmer/producer and the importance of agribusiness to the area economy.

This year the guest speaker is Mike Adams of Adams on Agriculture.

Mike Adams is host of the syndicated radio program Adams on Agriculture (heard locally on KFEQ). After working on a grain and livestock farm growing up in West Central Illinois, Adams began his radio career at WLDS in Jacksonville, Ill., working as a DJ, sportscaster and farm director for 27 years. In 2001 he became host of the nationally-syndicated radio program AgriTalk and served as host for 16 years.

A year ago he started the Adams on Agriculture program for the American Ag Network, focusing on ag policy and issues such as trade, renewable fuels and rural development. Adams is a past president of the National Association of Farm Broadcasting, past National Farm Broadcaster of the Year recipient and last fall was inducted into the NAFB Hall of Fame.
