The Teacher Externship Program is ramping up for July. We will have teachers and counselors who will visit six local businesses to learn about career opportunities for students. They will spend four days discovering skills they can take back to the classroom and apply. This program is a great way for teachers and counselors to see firsthand the jobs we have in St. Joseph.

The Chamber of Commerce is constantly evaluating the critical needs of local employers. Workforce rises to the top of most every conversation. The Chamber partnered with Buchanan County, the City of St. Joseph, the St. Joseph School District, the State of Missouri and several local employers to gather funding for a Manufacturing Simulation Center on the Hillyard Technical Center Campus. The Simulation Center is set to open this fall providing a unique training experience for students pursuing welding, machining and industrial maintenance. This initiative will allow program expansion in Allied Health with a new program being created for Diesel Mechanic training as well.

North Central Missouri College has recently opened a cam-

pus in Savannah that will service certificate programs in manufacturing, as well as its allied health programs. This is a great new asset to our region.

Missouri Western State University, in partnership with North Central Missouri College, will grow the region's skilled manufacturing and construction workforce by establishing the Convergent Technology Alliance Center. This is another example of a true public/private partnership to provide opportunities in the community. CTAC is set to open this fall.
